Produced by City Pigeons, the original play 'Dead Funny' delves into issues of heaven, hell, existence, fate, racism, new years eve drug fuelled raves and the flight potential of ducks while remaining light, entertaining and inherently simple.

Steve is shaving; he then proceeds to cut himself and DIES. Bleeding out patiently on the floor he decides he has waited long enough for DEATH. He picks himself up and continues to live. Death himself then comes looking for a corpse and finds living-breathing Steve – what happens next will be DEAD FUNNY.

Debuting during MUDFEST (The University of Melbourne Creative Arts Festival) then making the dash to the Melbourne Fringe Festival 'Dead Funny' will be the first production created and performed by youth-founded and run theatre company – City Pigeons Theatre.

Founded in 2011, City Pigeons Theatre brings smart fun and accessible theatre back to the Melbourne stage. For the City Pigeons, entertainment should be at the heart of all theatre; entertainment that is not just for theatre-ees but for everyone (that's right, even normal everyday folk).

Established by Two Young Melbourne Comedic Theatre Makers, City Pigeons Theatre is driven by a desire to bring kooky and simple characters mixed with simple comic narratives back to the Melbourne stage.
