Meditations

Melbourne-based photographic artist Kate Golding exhibits the landscape series, "Meditations" in the upstairs gallery of Off The Kerb in Collingwood. The images featured in this exhibition explore stillness in the natural environment and invite the viewer to contemplate, meditate and calm their mind. Each scene provides a focal point on which the mind may rest. The photographs are printed on sustainable paper crafted from bamboo fibres.

As urban dwellers our senses are constantly bombarded with manufactured stimuli, meditation creates a space in which we can rest. In seeking locations for this series the photographer sought scenes free of obstructions, scenes of beauty and stillness.

The resulting images are often majestic, often the result of calmly waiting for the right moment before releasing the shutter and occasionally a case of right place, right time. The photographs, captured on various travels throughout Australia and Europe, serve to remind us of the beauty of our natural environment to which we are intrinsically connected.

The works are printed on a warm-toned paper created from bamboo fibres. The matte finish gives depth to the images while providing a sustainable alternative to traditional photographic papers.
