Radio Mix

Radio Mix is an exhibition of new work from artist Julie Vinci. The show features a hand knitted 12 metre long replica paper chain as well as a hand sewn enlarged copy of an authentic 1980's radio mix cassette tape list.

The exhibition is showing at Bower Gallery in Ripponlea with special musical performance from Melbourne band, The Bowers on the 23rd September from 6pm.

The pieces in Radio Mix are tangible reflections of memories and moments in time.

A life size replica paper chain is copied from the ones made by the artist with her children when they were celebrating their first Christmas. The child's drawing of a garden scene, recreated with hand stitching, is taken from an image that was rounded up with the other drawings and thrown away as nothing more than nonsense scribbles.

Lastly a Side 1 and Side 2 of a cassette mix tape found at the local tip shop, has been saved from the rubbish heap and certain oblivion by being recreated in an enlarged hand sewn format.

These pieces are reminders of a time in ones life, not necessarily of an historic or socially important or significant time but definitely one of a more personal nature.

The exhibition will be opened with a special guest performance form The Bowers. Adding a live musical component takes the idea of the exhibition one step further by engaging with the audience to make a new memory that they can take away with them.
