Rendered Bones Joceline Lee - Solo Exhibition

Artist **Joceline Lee's** first solo exhibition, **Rendered Bones**, will premier at the **No Vacancy Project Space, Federation Square**. **Joceline's work explores animal bones, skeletal figures and anatomical studies. Working mostly in ink on paper, she re-imagines these structures, in bold and and subtle detail. Joceline's studies of bone structure have been informed by her recent artist residency at the Palaeontology Collection at the Melbourne Museum.**

Rendered Bones interprets the fragile nature of fossilised structures from both sketch models and physical configurations. Joceline's imagining of bone delicately layer between skeletal joints in geometric patchwork to present intricate translations of anatomical form.

The works premiered in her Melbourne Fringe Festival exhibition is the culmination of her year long participation in JUMP, the Australia Council's national mentoring program for young and emerging artists, with film maker and new media artist Rhian Hinkley. Rhian's work has appeared internationally in various forms and event contexts. Joceline is guided in her mentorship by Rob Delves, a practicing sculptor working on several large exhibition pieces. Rob's role in Joceline's mentorship supplements Rhian's work as mentor, and is an integral component of her mentorship and growth as an artist.

Both Rhian and Rob have been collaborating artists with Art Day South, an arts program for artists with disabilities run by Arts Access Victoria. Joceline's mentorship has been proudly supported by Arts Access Victoria and Arts Project Australia.
