But when they step up to the microphones, expectations are quickly shattered with one of the most lively, cheeky and downright fun vocal shows in the world.

Often teetering on the edge of good taste, these natural born performers can raise the roof with a crowd-pleaser in one breath and then send chills down every spine in the room with a heartfelt love song the next.

Book-ended by the Blain brothers, Loz and Chris, Suade's line-up includes music teacher and rugby giant Sava Djukic, opera diva Rob Latham and boy-genius counter-tenor Luke Stevenson. Together they deliver five-part vocal harmony like you've never heard it. It'll take you a while to even notice that there's no band or backing tracks in their show - just singing, beatboxing and a whole lot of fun.

As well as performing intelligent interpretations of some well-known songs, the lads have a huge arsenal of original music that will make you laugh, cry, cringe and sigh your way through the show.
