The Nontrepreneur

The Nontrepreneur chronicles the life of rising comedic talent James Muldoon as he is thrown into the chaotic world of the unskilled job market. As James turns 18, his parents divorce and he suddenly finds that his suburban upbringing has left him ill-equipped to deal with the precarious world of casual labour. Take a journey through song, story and dance as one man shows how he managed to blunder his way through 38 jobs in five years.

This effervescent performance twists through a labyrinth of bizarre characters, chance encounters and creepy moments shared between employer and employee. The multi-disciplinary and patch-work nature of the show mirrors the transient and disorienting experience of casual work: the late night bars, early morning deliveries and round the clock call centres bringing to life a world where time is always out of joint.

Become acquainted with a cast of characters that have populated James' dogged rise to underemployed philosophy student, from the cocaine dealing criminal lawyer Mr Sexton, to Sergio, the Italian baby from hell.

A captivating romp through the seedy underbelly of Melbourne's cash-in-hand jobs and fly-by-night operators, The Nontrepreneur will teach you everything you need to know about losing your job and lowering your self-esteem. A must for all employed Festival-goers.

James Muldoon is a classically trained philosopher and political activist. This is his debut show for the Melbourne Fringe Festival.
