WYRD with grace

Wyrd.... with grace is a collaboration of contemporary dance/music between Melbourne based dancer and emerging choreographer Alexandra Knox and musician Daniela Lucchetti. Performances will be held at Revolt in Kensington. Wyrd... with grace explores The Three Fates or the Wierd Sisters told through Nordic Mythology. From the verb weorþan, Wyrd means "to come to pass, to become". Spun from a single thread, a web is woven. The Wyrd illuminate the way.

Wyrd... with grace will explore the pathways in which we take to grace, wisdom and strength and how they play a hand in weaving our fate. The work is inspired by The Three Fates told through stories taken from Nordic Mythology. The Fates are Urdh (The selector of the thread), Verthandi (The Spinner) and Skuld (who cuts the thread). Spun from a single thread, a web is woven. Long and wide, it interweaves within and without itself. Old English Wyrd is a verbal noun formed from the verb weorþan, meaning "to come to pass, to become", also meaning destiny or supernatural/uncanny.
